SACRAMENTS INCLUDING RCIA

We will explore the importance, history, and expression of the seven sacraments in symbol and theology. The course will define sign and symbol and review the renewal of sacramental theology from Vatican II to the present incorporating the biblical, historical, and liturgical research into the new rites. Attention will be paid to the sacrament of holy orders; the theology and relationships of deacons to bishops, priests and laity. Emphasis will be on the sacrament of Eucharist to understand more clearly its development from Eucharist in the New Testament (with its roots in Jewish practice) through the Patristic era, the Protestant Reformation and the Liturgical movements culminating in the changes promulgated in *Sacrosanctum concilium*.
