The film covers Sister Dorothy's work for the poor of Brazil and her murder in the Brazilian rainforest. It then follows the courtroom drama of the actual trials of Sister Dorothy's killers. There are no actors in this remarkable Just Media film.

Sr. Dorothy Stang, SND, was killed in the Amazon rainforest for defending the rights of the landless poor in Brazil and for protecting the rainforest from destruction from loggers and the owners of big ranches. She was martyred on February 12, 2005 at the age of 73 years.
