Dear Faithful of the Diocese of El Paso,

Following the introduction of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) in 2002, the Diocese of El Paso has remained committed to protecting the children in each of our Catholic schools, parishes, faith-based programs, and youth ministry events.

To achieve full compliance with the requirements outlined in the Charter, the diocese offers age- appropriate child abuse prevention training for children to teach them about healthy boundaries, and the diocese also imposes strict requirements for all adults working with minors in their respective ministries. Requirements for Parents and children are addressed below.

## **Safe Environment Program for Children: Virtus “Teaching Safety – Empowering God’s Children”.**

Parents of children of Religious Formation and Catholic Schools are required to attend a Parent session and watch a yearly awareness video or module, which assist them in providing a safe environment for their children. At this session, a brief explanation of the training their children will receive is reviewed. Parents are also asked to sign the permission form to OPT in/out children to be trained. All children of catholic schools and religious formation are required to be trained in safe environment by a certified Lesson Leader.
